ECHO ZULU set the pace with her ears pricked while encountering mild pressure from an outer rival, felt sterner adversity as that foe and another outer rival ranged up around the far turn, shook narrowly clear of those foes at the quarter pole, held a margin through upper stretch under light hand urging, came under driving pressure entering the final furlong as HIDDEN CONNECTION again crept closer, dueled with that bidding foe through the late stages, and just lasted via a tight photo. HIDDEN CONNECTION stalked outside of the leading pair while in the four path, took aim while inching closer at the five sixteenths pole, briefly failed to keep pace with the leader entering the lane, kept on determinedly, grinded away through the final furlong to produce a late bid, but just missed. FAVOR lunged outwardly and severely bothered BERNABREEZY at the start, tracked along the inside, got outmoved by an outer bidding HIDDEN CONNECTION at the three furlong pole while awaiting racing room, slipped inside of a rival entering the lane to claim show at the quarter pole, then chased the top pair home. TURNERLOOSE stalked outside of the leader from the three path while only applying light pressure, moved forward at the three furlong pole to issue a challenge between horses turning for home, but yielded entering the lane. SEQUIST laid off of the pace along the inside, then in the two to three path around the far turn, and failed to factor. BERNABREEZY was severely hampered and lost all chance after being squarely knocked off balance by an inner foe at the start, and trailed throughout.
