TOP GUNNER with the pace while three wide backstretch, helped set a rapid opening quarter, continued to wing while edging clear late in the turn, well clear with a furlong remaining, enough left to hold off the runner up late. LYKAN outrun early off the inside, came three wide into the lane, finished fast to be rapidly getting to the winner. COUNTY FINAL vied up front in the run up the backstretch between rivals through those quick fractions, fell back off the winner late in the turn, moved out three wide into the lane, has little left for the stretch run but managed to save the show. ONE FAST CAT washy, raced well off the early pace and the inside, three wide into the stretch, lacked a closing response. MOLTO VIVACE with the pace along the inside four three furlong, in a bit tight early in the turn, fell back soon after, continued to weaken through the stretch. FLAP JACK last away, trailed most of the way in remaining back while racing in the two path. COLONEL BOWMAN saved ground to no avail, tired. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY AND CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF MOLTO VIVACE AGAINST COUNTY FINAL FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE INTO THE TURN, NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
