FLIGHTLINE broke a half a beat slow when lunging slightly from the gate, began to advance inside and was taken in hand and steadied lightly seven and a half furlongs from home as SPEAKER'S CORNER crossed briefly in front before taking to the two path, began to advance once more inside and was taken in hand six and a half furlongs from home as SPEAKER'S CORNER once more took over the rail in front, tipped to the two path six furlongs from home coming under very light coaxing, got floated three wide through the turn while making a steady advance to get on near even terms three furlongs out before taking over command nearing the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, drew clear under a drive and was geared down in the final seventy yards. HAPPY SAVER three to four wide in pursuit, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled five wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while running on to secure the place honors. SPEAKER'S CORNER established the front and crossed to the inside forcing FLIGHTLINE to steady off his heels seven and a half furlongs from home, tipped back to the two path and had FLIGHTLINE advance once more and tucked inside forcing that rival to again be taken in hand this time when latching on, remained inside and steadily came under pressure floating to the two path and carrying his main danger three wide through the turn getting put to coaxing as that rival got on near even terms three furlongs out, yielded the front nearing the five-sixteenths and went four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and weakened in the late stages while clear for the show honors. ALOHA WEST chased three then two wide under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, angled five to six wide into upper stretch and was outrun. INFORMATIVE chased four wide throughout under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths and trailed.
