KOOLHAUS vied for the lead outside of BRIGADIER GENERAL around the first turn while in the three path, inherited an advantage at the nine sixteenths pole, shifted down to the two path into the far turn as the aforementioned rival re-challenged to the outside, then shook free of that rival in upper stretch, and held resolute to the wire. ALEJANDRO laid off of the pace along the inside, tracked while inching closer in hand in the two path around the far turn, tipped a bit out in upper stretch to aim a rally between horses, grinded through the seam to bid for place, battled with his outer counterpart for that position through the late stages, and prevailed. GREATHEART stalked the top pair from the three path early on, ranged up outside of them and in the four path around the far turn, but only managed to chase while failing to keep pace with the clearing leader in upper stretch, fought on determinedly in the final furlong while brushing with an inner ALEJANDRO, battled for place in the late stages with that one, but was bested. BRIGADIER GENERAL vied for the lead inside of the eventual winner early on, rated back approaching the far turn to re-engage that foe from the outside entering that bend, attempted a bid entering the lane, but failed to keep pace in upper stretch, sustained place well into the final furlong, but yielded that position to a pair of outer rivals in the final sixteenth. PROTONIC POWER trailed in the three path around both turns, and was outrun.
