Footnotes

EL KABONG stalked comfortably along the inside, bid along the rail in upper stretch through a wide seam after the leader vacated the inside, drew clear approaching the furlong grounds, and held sway through the late stages. WIN WORTHY settled off of the pace two wide, took the far turn in the three path before shifting to the six path entering the lane, got nudged to the seven path while being outkicked by an inner foe, picked up stride shortly after, rallied outside of foes to bid for place entering the final sixteenth, and claimed that position shortly after while gaining on the clear leader. ARABIAN PRINCE tracked two wide and between horses, shifted to the four path in upper stretch while inside of KING VEGA (GB), chased among rivals in pursuit of the clear leader entering the final furlong, vied for place approaching the final sixteenth, but was outkicked leaving that station, then kept on to prevail over the aforementioned foe for show. KING VEGA (GB) stalked three wide, ranged up turning for home before drifting to the five path entering the lane, hung on his left lead while failing to progress, bid for place at the furlong grounds in pursuit of the clear leader, but was outkicked for that position entering the final sixteenth, and flattened out between horses. DANVILLE rated off of the pace along the inside, then in the two path around the far turn, shifted to the five path in upper stretch, and improved between horses late. AVIANO tracked from midpack in the three to four paths, nudged an outer foe while shifting to the six path in upper stretch, but lacked a rally between horses. COURAGEOUSLY set the pace along the inside, but vacated the rail entering the lane, which allowed for the eventual winner to shoot through along the rail, proved no match for that foe approaching the final furlong, and faded. COOL RAGS trailed, swung to the eight path entering the lane, and failed to factor. LANDBISCUIT prompted the pace two wide, but was outkicked in upper stretch before faltering between horses at the furlong grounds.
