Footnotes

HE'S IN CHARGE set the pace early, raced in the two path into the lane, drew clear down the lane and held safely in the final stages. RODERICK broke in at the start, stalked the early pace, was steadied along the rail in the turn, raced in the two path into the lane, made a bid down the lane but had no late gain on the winner in the final stages. KING'S OVATION tracked the pace early, was in the four path into the lane and flattened out late in the stretch run. KING'S MISCHIEF pressed the pace early on, raced in the four path into the lane and weakened late in the stretch drive. SUPER COMET was a step slow and bothered at the start, chased the pace for a half then folded up. CARMEL BAY was through after a half. GROVE DADDY was bothered at the start and trailed the field throughout.
