1 **FLIGHTLINE** has looked every bit the superstar many have been making him out to be in his only three appearances to date while keeping his races spaced and winning with complete authority; has plenty of questions to answer as he tries the mile while shipping for the first time but those things aren't supposed to be excuses for a horse that has looked this good; the most anticipated runner on the card has plenty to live up to. 2 **SPEAKER'S CORNER** makes things interesting with the top one after earning a 114 Beyer in the Carter; has plenty of ability in his own right and also has the same running style as **FLIGHTLINE**, potentially setting up a battle right from the jump. 3 **ALOHA WEST** shouldn't be simply overlooked as the rallying winner of last year's Breeders' Cup Sprint, especially if the two favorites are destined to hook it up; was too close to the pace last time when no match for Jackie's Warrior.
