MR PHIL was hustled to the front, contested the pace on the inside of a foe, vied inside around the turn, responded well when asked at the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed crop outside the furlong marker and held under strong urging. FORTIN HILL disputed the pace on the outside, was urged along in the three path around the turn, chased the winner under a drive in the stretch and finished willingly for the place. CHESTERTOWN moved up on the outside under urging, chased four to five wide around the turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and weakened but just held the show. LOBSTA tracked the pace down the backstretch, went four wide early on the turn then dropped to the two path, chased into upper stretch and tired then just missed the show. ZOOMER broke a step slow, settled at the rear, was urged three then four wide around the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. WHISTLING BIRDS settled near the back, was urged along in the two path on the turn, dropped back quickly late on that bend and faltered then was eased but walked off.
