Footnotes

CHASING THE CROWN raced in the four path along the first turn, tracked the pace early on, was in the two path along the far turn, shifted into the four path entering the lane while making a bid, edged past the leader near the eighth pole and cleared the field in the final stages. OLD HICKORY chased the pace early, raced in the three path along both turns, was in the five path into the lane, made a bid in the stretch and was up for place in the final stages. TEPEU raced back early on, was in the three path along both turns, swung into the six path entering the lane, made a bid down the lane and finished willingly in the late stages. SOSUA SUMMER raced in the three path along the first turn and vied for the early lead, took over command down the backstretch, was on the inside along the far turn, shifted into the three path entering the lane and faltered late in the stretch run. TIM TAL raced in the three path into the lane and moved up in the stretch drive. TOUCH CODE raced in the four path along the first turn while back early on, was in the five path into the lane and improved position down the lane. FRONTAL ASSAULT was rank into the first turn, raced in the three path along the first turn, was steadied a bit near the five

sixteenths pole, swung into the six path entering the lane and leveled off in the stretch. TEMPO MADNESS tracked the pace early, was in the three path into the lane and faded down the lane. FAITH RUNNER was bumped at the start, blocked and steadied near the five sixteenths pole. DINI D'AMORE was never involved. SPUNS SON stumbled badly at the start. CORRENTE DE OURO had early speed then folded up.
