WAYAKIN dueled early on two wide, was in the three path into the lane and drew away late in the stretch under a steady drive. QUICK TO BLAME tracked the pace early, was in the five path into the lane while no match for the winner in the stretch but was second best. CIVIL WAR was bumped along the backstretch, raced in the six path into the lane and rallied for show late in the stretch run. MINNESOTA READY chased the pace early along the inside, was in the five path into the lane and missed show late in the stretch drive. B DAWK tracked the pace early, was in the four path into the lane while making a bid but weakened late in the stretch. SOROS dueled early on from the inside, was in the two path into the lane and gave way down the lane. GREENER PASTURES was bumped along the backstretch, raced in the six path into the lane and was empty late in the stretch. TANGO CHARLIE was bumped along the backstretch, raced in the seven path into the lane.
