Footnotes

GULFSTREAM WAY pressed the pace two wide, bid entering the lane, dueled through upper stretch before gaining an advantage approaching the furlong grounds, and drew clear. DARK TIMBER set the pace inside of a pressing GULFSTREAM WAY, battled with that bidding foe in upper stretch, got headed approaching the furlong pole, flopped back to his left lead leaving that junction, yielded, but lasted for place. RED KNOBS bumped with an inner rival at the start, tugged to an inside stalking position early on, but only managed to chase the top pair through the lane while dueling with an outer FLAGS UP for show, and prevailed via a tight photo finish. FLAGS UP chased three wide, vied for show along with an inner RED KNOBS through the final furlong, but just missed. SPEND BENJAMINS saved ground while tracking the pace from midpack, then stayed on two wide and between horses in the final furlong, but failed to reach a minor share. SWIFT TAP bumped squarely with an outer foe at the start, raced four wide while off of the pace and outside of foes, and lacked a rally through the lane. BERNIE LOMAX tucked two wide down the backstretch while off of the pace, tracked from between horses around the turn, but made little impact. KEEN HEIR was outrun.
