Footnotes

ABSOLUTELY ZERO vied between rivals for command then moved to the inside on the turn, fought two wide into the stretch, battled with TAHOMA down the lane and proved best in the final sixteenth. TAHOMA stalked well off the rail, bid four then five wide outside the top trio on the turn, fought with ABSOLUTELY ZERO in the lane but was bested in deep stretch. PURE FIRE tracked along the inside then two wide into the stretch, tipped out at the top of the lane and summoned a mild rally. POP D'ORO broke a bit slow then lost his path at the start, navigated the turn five wide and finished evenly late to earn the a minor award. SALTA raced up close four then three deep on the backstretch, vied between rivals while four wide leaving the turn, could not keep up entering the final furlong and flattened late. CASTLEKNOCK showed early speed inside a trio of rivals then ceded control past the half-mile pole, chased along the rail to the stretch and lacked a late bid. MIDNIGHT LIGHTNING vied three deep early then fought outside the winner into the turn, vied between three wide leaving the bend and weakened. GOOD N THIRSTY stumbled a bit leaving the gate, chased two to three wide around the bend and weakened. SMOKEM HOWARD was off a bit slow to begin, trailed five then four wide on the turn and was not a factor.
