STONE SILENT brushed the gate but still came away quickly, sprinted clear to take control, saved ground through the turn, drew away in upper stretch and held safely under urging. TOM'S REGRET stumbled badly leaving the gate, drifted out and brushed past the half-mile pole, rounded the turn three wide, altered around ROUSING JEWEL into the stretch, then finished willingly for the place honors. E Z PHARIS was off a bit slow from inside but recovered quickly and was forwardly placed, drifted out and bumped ROUSING JEWEL at the five-sixteenths pole, lacked the needed response in the drive but held the show. DANCING MO brushed with TOM'S REGRET leaving the gate, dropped back early, went two wide into the turn, moved to the rail then angled out leaving the bend, steered out further in upper stretch and failed to threaten. ROUSING JEWEL away quickly in the beginning, closest in pursuit from the two path into the turn, got bumped by E Z PHARIS at the five-sixteenths pole, jumped the track three wide into the stretch and weakened. PADDLE ON POLLY was off a bit slow from outside, chased outside TOM'S REGRET and brushed with that rival past the half-mile pole, navigated the turn four wide and tired.
