HAVNAMELTDOWN hustled from the gate and cleared the field, steered to the inside and set the pace on the inside to the stretch, urged left-handed in deep stretch and remained clear. MISTER ICEMAN broke well then took a stalking position outside a rival, bid two wide into the stretch, could not summon the needed late kick to overtake the winner but was stayed on to prove second best. DILLINGER broke awkwardly at the start, chased three deep into the turn, closed in around the bend, bid three deep into the stretch but was no match for the tp pair late. PURE FIRE raced in mid-pack off the rail, lacked room behind a rival entering the turn, angled down to the inside and kept on to fill out the superfecta. SKINNER broke a bit slow and bumped with inner rival, drifted out on the backstretch, entered the lane four to five wide and improved position. ALEXANDER HELIOS raced in range between rivals entering the turn, exited the bend three wide and lacked a rally. BOLT FROM HEAVEN was off slow to begin, navigated the turn three then four wide and also lacked a rally. JANUARY MAGIC broke well then began to climb and dropped back early, raced off the rail to the stretch and was not a factor. TOP GUN CLASSIC bobbled slightly at the start, chased along the rail then two wide into the drive and faded. DEEP RIVER broke a bit slow and bumped with outside rival, became a bit rank early, traveled a bit off the rail into the lane and proved no menace.
