Footnotes

B DAWK prompted the pace three wide, bid for the lead approaching the five sixteenths pole, led turning for home as an outer RAYMOND loomed a danger, but repelled that foe nearing midstretch, and drove clear leaving the furlong grounds. OPEN ROAD was bumped between horses while put to crowded quarters among foes at the start, trailed between horses early on, raced off of the pace four to five wide around the turn, commenced a rally turning for home, sustained his charge to take aim on RAYMOND for place in the final furlong, and reached that position nearing the wire. RAYMOND tracked three wide while outside of foes, ranged up four wide to bid outside of B DAWK turning for home, but briefly delayed his lead change in upper stretch, flattened out while failing to keep pace with his inner counterpart in the process, then got outfinished by an outer foe for place. IGNITIS brushed an outer foe at the start, chased two wide and between horses, tipped three wide entering the lane, and ran on while fending off an outer foe for fourth through the final furlong. KUNSHAN BRIDGE laid off of the pace in the two to three path, shifted four wide entering the lane, but lacked a bid. COURTHOUSE COVE bumped an inner foe at the start, vied for the lead two wide and between horses, but was outkicked turning for home by a pair of outer foes, and tired. BLUE NORTHER set the pace inside of a pair of prompting rivals, but weakened while inside of a trio of foes at the quarter pole. HOLIDAY HOUSE bumped with rivals on either side at the start, stalked along the inside, but faded while tipping two wide entering the lane. LEEVEE PROUD was outrun.
