AH JEEZ forwardly placed outside the top pair early on, challenged three deep on the turn, kicked clear approaching the eighth pole and drew away under right-handed urging. STORMING MACHINE got bumped around on both sides at the start then bumped again soon after, stalked three deep to the turn, launched a bid four deep, could not go on with the winner in the final furlong but stayed on to best the rest. KOLOMIO broke alertly then got put in tight and lost ground, moved inside tracking the pace, lacked room behind the leader entering the stretch, remained inside through the lane and got up for third. CANDY CARAMEL got bumped hard leaving the gate then bumped again in the early going, chased between foes then waited for room on the turn, tipped three wide into the stretch, moved out further and bumped rival at the sixteenth pole and was edged for the show. BLUEGRASS RYDER got bumped on both sides leaving the gate, gave chase two then three wide on the turn, tipped out into the stretch, got bumped by CANDY CARAMEL with a sixteenth remaining and could not find more late. CROWNING GOLD broke a step slow then hustled to the front on the inside, set the pace under pressure to the turn, maintained a short lead inside a trio of rivals entering the lane, gave up command in upper stretch and weakened. JERRY JEFF WALKER broke in and bumped rival at the start, dropped back early, raced off the rail then angled in on the turn and failed to menace. ZOOKEEPER broke well and prompted the pace from outside, vied between foes entering the stretch and faded.
