**Footnotes**

FORT BRAGG stalked three deep early under a hold, inched up into the far turn, took over near the five-sixteenths pole, cleared at the quarter pole, lugged out at the top of the stretch, lugged back to the inside and bumped PRACTICAL MOVE midstretch and lost command, then came back and drew clear late. PRACTICAL MOVE stumbled leaving the gate, chased four wide around clubhouse turn, remained wide up the backstretch, gained and took aim four wide into the stretch, got impeded by FORT BRAGG at the top of the stretch, switch to the inside and got bumped midstretch while taking command but faltered late. MIXTO chased three then four wide on the first turn, entered the lane four to five wide, put in late run and earned the show honors. RIVERSIDE tucked inside on the first turn and stalked the pace, moved out to the two path on the far turn, tipped out into the lane, drifted in upper stretch then drifted back out and got edged for the show. MUCINO got put in tight entering the first turn and steadied, moved into range off the rail on the backstretch, came four wide into the lane, altered in then back out, then lacked room between rivals late and lost all momentum. FLEET FEET was closest in pursuit on the outside, applied pressure midway up the backstretch, took over with three furlongs remaining, lost command at the five-sixteenths pole and weakened. RICH GOLD was off tardily, trailed to the far turn and passed tired rivals. NULLARBOR cleared and angled in, showed the way up the backstretch, lost command at the three-eighths pole and gave way. CAPACITY chased two wide then dropped back on the backstretch, trailed into the stretch and had little left. THE RIDER ABOARD PRACTICAL MOVE LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST FORT BRAGG AND THERE WAS ALSO A STEWARDS' INQUIRY. FOLLOWING A REVIEW, FORT BRAGG WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM FIRST TO SECOND FOR LUGGING OUT INTO THE PATH OF PRACTICAL MOVE AT THE TOP OF THE LANE THEN LUGGING IN AND MAKING CONTACT MIDSTRETCH WHICH COST PRACTICAL MOVE A CHANCE AT A BETTER PLACING.
