Footnotes

CAN'T HUSH THIS saved ground while being forwardly placed, angled out three-wide nearing the quarter pole, took the lead nearing the eighth pole and prevailed under pressure. LEBLON was reserved off the early place, moved up entering the stretch, lacked room running up on horses nearing the three-sixteenths pole, angled out for room and finished fast. CARMICHAEL stalked the pace while racing two-wide, offered a bid entering the stretch, but lacked the needed late response. TEST PILOT saved ground setting the pace into the stretch and weakened slightly late. TUANIS saved ground while being unhurried and passed tiring rivals. KING'S OVATION was prominently placed early while racing between horses and weakened. BOURBON THUNDER prompted the early pace while racing three-wide and tired.
