Footnotes

DECORATED INVADER tracked patiently inside behind the leader on the turn, waited for running room at the top of the stretch, bullied his way through to split dueling leaders at the furlong marker and drew away nearing the finish. BREAKING ALONE was allowed to settle near the back in the early stages of the race, looked for room in the six path in upper stretch, angled outside seven wide for clear run at the eighth pole and closed well besting the rest at the finish. HENLEY'S JOY was situated in midfield outside rivals three eighths to the line, angled outside to be eight wide rallying at the top of the lane, arguably poked his head in front briefly at the eighth pole and needed a little more to threaten in deep stretch. A THREAD OF BLUE travelled in the middle of the field inside running on the turn, shifted out to be seven wide for the stretch drive, was in range with the leaders an eighth to the line and stalled a touch to settle for a small share. LIKE THE KING had command from the onset, continued to dictate the pace at the half, was headed outside turning for home, fought on

inside until the furlong marker and tired nearing the wire. ENTRY TO HEAVEN stalked near the back in the beginning, looked to rally five wide behind horses at the top of the stretch, lacked clear running room in mid stretch and finished up evenly the final sixteenth. DAY TRIPPER pressed the frontrunner through the turn, offered a strong bid four wide two furlongs to the wire, gave way while in tight quarters inside the eighth pole and faded the final sixteenth. ROCKET JOE COPPER stalked mid pack four wide through the turn, angled out seven wide two furlongs to the finish, was roused in upper stretch, offered no response and gave way. KEEP GRINDING tracked three wide just off the leaders on the turn, was in contention in the five path at the quarter pole, steadied while between rivals nearing the furlong marker and was not persevered with afterwards to the wire. SOUP AND SANDWICH hopped at the break, trailed the field at the half, angled for clear run in the nine path in upper stretch and could not reach contention running to the finish.
