Footnotes

SUITABLE stalked the pace early on, raced in the four path along the turn, was in the five path into the lane, made a bid down the lane under a long drive and edged clear in the final stages. YACHT ROCK (IRE) tracked the pace early on three wide, raced in the four path into the lane, was under a long drive down the lane and gave in during the final stages. BORN FLAWLESS pressed the pace early two wide, was in the three path into the lane and weakened late in the stretch run. LED TASSO was a tad slow at the start, chased the pace early, raced in the four path into the lane and flattened out late in the stretch drive. COLLECTORATE raced back early on, was in the five path along the turn, in the seven path into the lane and leveled off late in the stretch. DUPLANTIS was slow at the start, raced in the five path into the lane and improved position down the lane. COACH ROGERS set the pace for a half then folded up. LET'S GO RANDOM was slow at the start and through after a half. KING SHAMAN was never a factor. WINNING DANCE was in tight at the start and never a threat.
