NITROUS CHANNEL set the pace in the two path, was roused around the turn, opened up slightly from the three path into the stretch, and held safe. JUDGE DAVIS stalked along the inside, was ridden along while tipping out to the four path turning into the lane, and kept on to hold place. BOURBON CREED was behind in the four path going into the turn, shifted to the rail and passed a pair of outer tiring foes around the turn, was coaxed while angling back out and floated to the eight path into the stretch, and ran on down the center for show. GIANT GAME tracked in the four path, took aim while under a drive in the six path turning into the stretch, but evened out late. PALACE KITTEN chased along the inside but flattened in the stretch. KISSALOT was outrun early in the five path and never threatened. TOO MUCH ACTION prompted the pace in the three path but yielded from the five path in upper stretch.
