HOWE STREET settled off the pace while racing three wide, advanced four wide around the far turn, swept to the front in upper stretch and drew off under a

drive. PATOU ROAD raced in range two wide, bid three wide around the far turn, was no match for the winner but kept on well to be clearly second best. MEYER raced off the pace four wide and ran on to gain the show. DRIPPING GOLD failed to menace while racing three wide. SO HIGH (GB) stalked the pace inside early, remained up close three wide around the clubhouse turn, bid two wide into the far turn, took the lead near the five-sixteenths pole and tired in the lane. PARATUS played no factor while racing two wide. HASHTAG NO WONDER was outrun inside. EXPERIENCED chased the pace two wide and came up empty in the lane. GRAND JOURNEY pressed the pace two wide around the first turn, cleared and angled in approaching the clubhouse turn, led inside to the five-sixteenths marker and retreated. SWING LOW hit the starting gate, saved ground and never threatened. TRENDING led inside early, chased inside down the backstretch and faltered around the far turn. WHAT SAY THEE saved ground and made little impact.
