Footnotes

DRIPPING GOLD prompted the pace two wide, vied around the far turn, dueled gamely through the lane, and prevailed. F FIVE set the pace along the inside, vied with an outer rival around the far turn, dueled gamely through the lane, but was narrowly bested. JARREAU stalked along the inside, remained pocketed in the two path around the far turn, tipped outside of the embattled leading pair with multiple lengths to find in upper stretch, but failed to progress on them in the final furlong, and saved show from an inner rivals late. SOLID COUNTRY GOLD settled off of the pace along the inside, took the far turn in the two path, rallied along the inside through the lane, and missed reaching show while gaining fourth at the wrie. WHAT SAY THEE tracked two wide and between horses, then in the three path around the far turn, and chased evenly. POLICY OPTION broke half a beat slow while subtly tossing his head, rated at the rear two wide, the improved between horses. SPIN WHEEL pulled while rank along the inside racing through the lane for the first time, steadied into the first turn, saved ground in midpack after settling around the first turn, but tired. NICHOLAS JONES saved ground while unhurried, encountered traffic in the three path in upper stretch, and lacked a bid. ICONIC ADVENTURE laid off of the pace three to four wide, then faded after being floated five wide in upper stretch. MAINTAINER tracked three wide, but faded four wide in upper stretch. EXPLOSIVE got hung in the five path while far back, attempted to circle inner rivals around the far turn, but tired without reaching contention. JR'S GIFT lacked speed in the four path, and faded around the far turn.
