SKIMS (GB) rated two to three wide just off the pace, remained patiently handled until set down spinning three wide into upper stretch, rallied to split rivals a furlong out seizing command just inside that station, then edged clear to the finish. ATOMIC BLONDE (GER) was under a rating hold tracking the front from near the rear of the compact group, came under coaxing just off the inside at the five-sixteenths, continued just off the inside into upper stretch, tipped out inside the eighth pole and offered up a mild kick to secure the place honors. CANISY rated two to three wide in closest aim of the leader, pulled her way to latch on that rival five furlongs from home, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths when MISE EN SCENE advanced inside, swung four wide into upper stretch issuing a challenge for command, dug in under a drive taking over the front narrowly and briefly before being headed by the eventual winner, then ran on to preserve the show honors. MISE EN SCENE (GB) tracked the pace along the inside in hand, got given a nudge at the three-eighths and advanced inside to bid for command with five-sixteenths to go, cut the corner on even terms for the front scraping the paint, dug in under a drive among a quartet latched on to the eighth pole and weakened in the late stages. STAR DEVINE (IRE) away well, raced three wide into the first turn showing the way, tucked to the two path through that bend before tipping back three wide down the backstretch, held a safe advantage through sensible splits unhurried and uncontested, had CANISY advance outside pulling her way to be heads apart five furlongs from home but still faced little pressure as that rival remained on hold as well, came under challenge for the initial time just past the midway point on the far turn as MISE EN SCENE advanced inside, came under coaxing near the quarter pole now under threat from flanking challengers, spun just off the inside into upper stretch let out for the drive, dug in and was collared nearing the eighth pole, then weakened through to the finish. PHAROAH'S HEART tracked the pace along the inside until tipped to the two path five furlongs from home, came under coaxing three wide at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch and trailed throughout.
