GAL IN A RUSH four then three wide in pursuit, came under coaxing near the quarter pole, swung three wide into upper stretch, took over command with three-sixteenths to go and edged away under a drive kept to task. DIAMOND HANDS broke out at the start and was corrected, showed the way in hand along the inside, got set down taking the inside route into upper stretch, got collared with three-sixteenths to run and ran on to secure the place honors clear of the rest. CANDLE chased three then two wide, tipped out three wide midway on the turn, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch and stayed on one paced to the end. VIENNA CODE chased three then two wide under coaxing from the three-eighths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, weakened. POND WALKER (GB) chased along the inside pulling on the bit a bit keen early on forcing the rider to take hold briefly twice down the backstretch, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, took the inside route into upper stretch and tired.
