FOR REGISTERED INDIANA BRED THREE YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee, \$200 to pass the entry box and an additional \$200 to start. Supplementary nominations may be made by the usual time of closing of entries for a fee of \$1,000 which includes entry and starting fees with \$250,000 guaranteed. After paying 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Tuesday, July 25. Entries to be made at the usual time of closing. Trophy to the winning owner. This race will be limited to 12 starters. If more than 12 horses pass the entry box preference will be given to those with the highest weights. Second preference will be highest lifetime earnings. Entry fee only will be refunded if failure to draw into the race. (S)

KING ICE was off awkwardly, trailed, then rallied five wide at the three-eighths pole and drew off under a strong hand ride. RUN AWAY ROJO stalked the pace inside, bid at the quarter pole, was clear briefly but then couldn't hold off the winner. CORONA GRANDE stalked the pace in the four path, bid at the quarter pole, then faltered late. WIN ME OVER pressed the pace in the three path, bid on the far turn but yielded late. DOUBLEDOGJUSTICE raced four wide, then faded in the stretch. BAD BOY GEIST led in the two path before giving way in the stretch. SECRET RENDEZVOUS saved ground, bid at the quarter pole but faltered in the stretch. J'S NAUGHTY BOY passed tired rivals. SECRETO DE AMORE was off awkwardly, then raced evenly. PAYNTER'S CANVAS bobbled at the start. TAILLIGHTS was bumped at the start, was steadied on the first turn, stalked the pace inside, then gave way on the far turn.

LOOKING GOOD LEWIS pressed the pac between rivals, then gave way at the quarter pole.
