## Footnotes

SLIDER was closest pursuer to the turn, moved up bit around the bend, bid in upper stretch, gained front passing eighth marker and kicked clear late. E J WON THE CUP sped clear in early going, set pace along the inside, was overtaken passing eighth pole but clearly held second. UTOPIAN chased on two wide path into and on the turn, between rivals in upper stretch, continued on willingly and gamely gained third. TEJON PASS was slow to begin, taken off rail early, continued three then four wide on the turn then five wide into the stretch and outfinished for third. CONCORD BRIDGE stalked from the inside, remained along the rail into the stretch and lost placing late in the drive. DIVINO broke out, chased two wide, came out further exiting the bend then angled back in some in the lane. ARIO was forwardly placed early, tracked leaders three wide, continued four wide into the stretch and weakened. WHITE MOUNTAIN had path taken out of the gate and was slow into stride, chased two or three wide, drifted four wide leaving the bend and lacked needed rally. DEALERS SPECIAL hesitated at the start to be off well behind the field, angled three then four wide around the turn and failed to menace. LAWLESS WORLD was put into tight quarters and squeezed back shortly after the start, chased from off the rail and did not rally.
