GILMORE was hustled from the gate, went four to five wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, rounded the far turn in the four path, made a bid when asked near the five-sixteenths, dueled outside of the runner-up under a left-handed crop in upper stretch, came in some when given one pop of a right-handed crop approaching the sixteenth-pole then was corrected by the rider, had the rider throw exaggerated crosses near his opponent with the left-rein from that point to the finish and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. ANTARES raced in the three path on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, took the lead in the two path with three furlongs to run, turned into upper stretch on even terms with the winner, drifted out under a left-handed
crop near the furlong marker then switched to a right-handed crop, fought on gamely to the finish and just missed while clear for the place. ASKARI broke out at the start, moved in to save ground on the first turn, settled towards the rear, angled from the two path to the five path under urging on the far turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and finished willingly for the show. SIGNATOR was hustled from the gate, went five then four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused late on the backstretch, traveled four then five wide under urging on the far turn, gained late on that bend, held a good striking position into upper stretch, remained on his inside lead until the furlong marker then swapped to the proper lead and flattened out. WINTERS LION was hustled from the gate, dropped from the two path to the rail on the first turn, settled off the pace, came under urging outside the half-mile pole, saved ground on the far turn, spun three wide into the stretch and failed to respond. NARCISO DALI went to the front, showed the way on the inside with company to his outside, lost the lead at the three-eighths pole, dropped back coming to the quarter-pole, drifted out while retreating near the furlong marker and capitulated. KIGALI broke a bit slow then was forced out, went three to four wide on the turns and was no factor. MIDNIGHT TROUBLE was hustled from the start, went five then four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, came up empty while three to four wide on the far turn and retreated.
