STORMING MACHINE broke well, pressed the pace outside of ATTA BOY LLOYD while always traveling well, took command passing the guarter pole, drew off to an open lead, finished strong and was never threatened. GODSEND was under a ride from the break, found a good rhythm heading to the three furlong marker, gradually cut into the leading margin of the dueling leaders then finished up well under left handed urging to gain second while slowly gaining on, but never a threat to the winner. ATTA BOY LLOYD got squeezed at the start then was being leaned on by STORMING MACHINE for a few strides, recovered, then set off for the lead, was joined by that foe to the outside, dueled through the turn racing away from the rail, jumped a rough patch in the turn near the five-sixteenths pole causing a slight loss of momentum, weakened in the stretch but ran on well enough to hold the third spot. GALLO DEL CIELO was outrun from the break, chased the field through the turn, tipped out a path into the stretch and finished with some late interest while racing greenly. MAVERICK ROSE veered out from the break and was extremely wide in the early stages, moved closer going into the turn then drifted out, came under pressure from the quarter pole but could not make up any ground late and was tiring before the final furlong.
