Footnotes

STRETCH RIDE stalked the pace early, raced in the three path into the lane, rallied late in the stretch and drove past the leader in the final stages. AGOO tracked the pace early three wide, was in the four path into the lane, the rider lost the whip nearing the three sixteenths pole while making a bid, took over and inched clear inside the eighth pole but was caught in the final stages. NO JUDGMENT chased the pace early, was in the five path into the lane, made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late in the drive. HANDSOME HERB was a tad slow at the start, set the pace early on, was off the rail into the lane, under a long drive down the lane, gave in near the sixteenth pole and yielded late. NYQUIST FREQUENCY raced back early on, was in the five path into the lane and moved up late in the stretch run. ANDY'S CANDY was a bit slow at the start and never a threat. MAX'S MAP chased the pace early, was off the rail into the lane and faded late in the stretch drive. WITH FULL HONORS was a bit slow at the start and never a factor. MIDNIGHT MAESTRO trailed the field throughout.
