WEYHILL ROAD tracked three wide, rallied to bid in upper stretch and drove clear in the final furlong. NATION leaned in at the start, raced off of the pace while keenly shifted out to the five path into the first turn, pursued from the three path into the far turn, fanned back to the six path nearing the lane, offered a good kick to reach place at the wire. HEART N SOUL set the pace along the inside, but was headed at the furlong grounds, gave way and was nailed at the wire for place. NOW THAT ICAN ROCK stalked along the inside and chased evenly. AS ONE DOES tracked in the two path, but steadied and lost action nearing the three quarter pole and failed to menace. CROSSING pressed two wide, but gave way between horses. LITTLE NICK broke a step slow, lacked speed in the two path and moved up. EGYPTIAN KING pursued from the four path but yielded between horses while hanging on his left lead. COMMAND' ORO saved ground to no avail. MOESAHANDFUL broke inwardly and made little impact along the inside. ADDED MISCHIEF broke slowly, trailed and failed to factor. TEXAS TOAST raced keenly between horses into the first turn, checked in the three path behind a troubled rival nearing the backstretch and faded between rivals around the far turn.
