JAXON TRAVELER prompted the early pace and made a two wide bid on the turn to take over by the quarter pole, then drew off in the drive to prove much the best under crop urging, sharp. PRAYER OF JABEZ stalked the pace three wide, made a three wide bid on the turn, but proved to be no match for the winner while clearly second best. COMPETITIVE IDEA chased the pace on the inside, eased out and came three wide into the lane lacked the needed bid while besting the rest. TRUTH SEEKER was outrun early, swung wide leaving the turn and had a belated rally to gain the last spot in the superfecta. ALBIZU was settled early, two to three wide on the turn and lacked a rally. MINISTER OF SOUL was settled three wide, came five wide into the lane and had no rally. DIAMOND RIM was reserved early, came six wide into the lane and failed to threaten. TOO MUCH ACTION was reserved on the inside and failed to menace. TACTICAL ATTACK set the pace on the inside and faltered. TULANE TRYST was settled back early, came seven wide into the lane and was not a factor.
