COWBOY MIKE stalked from inside in-hand, tipped out at the five-sixteenths pole, challenged two wide into the lane, took over at the top of the stretch, put away HAWKER at the eighth pole, met the challenge from YELLOW BRICK shortly after and turned that rival back. YELLOW BRICK off slow to begin, moved inside and sat off the pace, drew closer in the middle stages, chased along the rail then two wide on the second bend, tipped out and launched a bid outside COWBOY MIKE at the eighth pole but was turned away in the furlong grounds. DON'T SWEAR DAVE got put in tight briefly between rivals early, moved into the two path, chased in range three deep into the far turn, four deep midway around the bend, continued within striking distance with a furlong left to run but flattened out while holding the show. MIDNIGHT MAMMOTH climbed early racing well off the rail and dropped back, roused four then three wide on the far turn, summoned a mild rally and missed third. CLOUSEAU tracked on the inside then two wide early, had to steady off heels past the five-eighths pole, ran into traffic at the quarter pole, angled to the inside and churned on to improve. HAWKER showed speed from the rail and dueled from inside early, cleared on the backstretch, challenged from outside into the lane, lost command in upper stretch and weakened. BAD SNEAKERS chased

three wide early, moved closer outside rivals on the backstretch, stayed off the rail to the stretch and faded. THE BIG WAM broke a step slow, trailed off the rail around the first turn, raced along the rail leaving the backstretch, angled out at the quarter pole and was never a factor. JEWELED SHILLELAGH dueled into the first turn then tried to cede command to inner rival but pulled the rider along, was taken hold of early on the backstretch, chased between rivals into the second bend, dropped back around the turn and tired.
