Footnotes

JUSTIFREAK set the pace inside of a pair of pressers into the turn, dueled with only UNCLE WILLIAM turning for home, gamely clung to an advantage through midstretch and shook free late. UNCLE WILLIAM was tough to load, pressed two wide and between horses, sparred with his inner counterpart turning for home, battled through midstretch but was turned away late. BANNED FOR LIFE stalked outside of the top pair, chased them while failing to sustain pressure turning for home, then kept on willingly through the lane. BOURBON'S FAULT broke out and bumped a rival at the start, tracked along the inside, shifted off of the rail while pursuing turning for home, then chased while one paced through the lane. THINK BIG was off slowly, spotted the leaders multiple lengths and shifted in at the start, laid off of the pace along the inside, advanced shifting out to the four path around the bend, swung out to the seven path entering the lane, shifted in and stayed on. MONDOGETSBUCKETS took light contact from an inner rival at the start, chased from midpack in the four to five path, floated wider in midstretch and failed to menace. ACCIDENT broke a step slow and steadied between horses at the start, trailed in the three to two path, then improved up the rail through the lane. HANDSOME HERB broke slowly and got floated inwardly while last away, pursued from off of

the pace two wide and between horses, and failed to factor. NEON NIGHTS transferred contact from an inner rival to an outer foe at the start, laid off of the pace two wide, got floated to the five path around the turn and failed to factor. MISCHIEVOUS M pursued from midpack along the inside, checked in cramped quarters into the turn, chased ground, chased into midstretch and tired late. SHOW MASTER broke a step slow, lacked speed in the four to three path and made little impact. STINGER BEE was bumped by an inner rival into an outer foe at the start, pursued from midpack in the three path and between horses, then weakened.
