ARTISLAS settled outside a rival, angled in and gained through the turn, swung out into the lane, rallied five deep into the final sixteenth and drove clear to prove best. CAJUN GOLD broke in and bumped, stalked from inside, needed room in upper stretch, bid between rivals in the furlong grounds but got outkicked by the winner. SCIPIO off slow to begin, trailed outside a rival, took the turn two wide, steered out in upper stretch and closed well. IRON MAN CAL stalked the top pair two wide, ridden along around the bend, tipped out in upper stretch, bid four deep and got outkicked. PALI KITTEN dueled up the backstretch then pressed from outside into and around the bend, fought to the sixteenth pole and faltered late. KALE'S ANGEL dueled from inside then inched ahead leaving the backstretch, maintained a short lead through the turn, dug in to the sixteenth pole and folded late. WESTWOOD broke a step slow, traveled inside a rival at the back, got boxed in briefly early on the turn, tipped two wide and was never a factor. KARANATHOS took a bump in the early stages, laid off the pace and steered to the rail, lost positions on the turn and had little left for the stretch run.
