**Footnotes**

SURF CITY raced back early on from the inside, stayed near the rail into the lane, took over command near the eighth pole and drew clear late under a steady drive. ROCK N ROLL BOLT was bumped and bothered at the start, raced in the two path into the lane, altered out down the lane under a rally and was up for place in the final stages. ALCOVE was bumped at the start, pressed the pace early, raced in the four path into the lane, was bumped near the eighth pole and lost place in the final stages. FLY J'S FUNTASTIC shied a bit at the start, tracked the pace early on, raced in the three path into the lane, came out near the eighth pole and flattened out late in the drive. BIG HAMMER came out at the start and trailed the field early on, raced in the five path into the lane with a mild gain late in the stretch run. INSANITY IT SEEMS veered out at the start, set the pace early on, raced in the two path into the lane, drifted out down the lane and faltered late in the drive. HAPPY GREY broke out at the start and raced back early on, was in the three path into the lane, made a bid in the stretch but leveled off late in the drive. BEBEDOURO was through after a half. DELIBERATION was done early.
