STAKES Ellis Park Derby Presented by Hallway Feeds Listed - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS . Free nomination, \$500 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at time of entry by payment of \$2,000 (includes entry and starting fees). \$150,000 Guaranteed plus an additional \$125,000 KTDF for KTDF eligible horses. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth Weight: 122 lbs. NonWinners of a graded sweepstakes at a mile or over in 2024 allowed 2, lbs. a sweepstakes at a mile or over since March 9, 4 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The maximum number of starters for the Ellis Park Derby will be limited to twelve (12) starters. If more than 12 pass the entry box preference to start will be given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III) then those horses having accumulated the highest lifetime earnings. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Saturday, July 27, 2024 with 25 nominations and 1 supplement.

Footnotes

MOST WANTED set the pace from the outset, raced off the rail into the lane, inched clear down the lane and lasted at the wire. NOT THIS BOY stalked the pace early on, raced in the three path into the lane, was under a long bid down the lane while gaining and just missed at the wire. WHO DEY stumbled at the start and trailed the field early on, raced in the five path into the lane, rallied down the lane with a late bid but did not have enough in the final stages. NATIVE LAND tracked the pace early on three wide, was in the four path into the lane while making a bid but faded late in the drive. STRETCH RIDE hit the gate and almost lost the rider at the start, tracked the pace early on, raced in the two path into the lane and was empty down the lane.
