DEMOLISHER led inside and drew off unthreatened under a mild drive. BLACK WHITE N GOLD stalked the pace inside, bid at the half-mile pole but was no match. ZOLO stalked the pace between rivals and bid late for the show. HOBNOBIN GENERAL was unrushed early and rallied belatedly in the five path.

HIGHEST MEMORIES was unrushed in the two path and improved position late. PAYNTER'S CANVAS saved ground but had no late bid. MOWINS hopped at the start and improved position late outside to finish on even terms with RUN AWAY ROJO who pressed the early pace between rivals, gave way at the three-eighths pole and faded in the stretch. C. J'S STORM pressed the pace in the four path and gave way at the half-mile pole. BERLONE stalked the pace between rivals before giving way in the stretch. ONE BIG DUDE pressed the pace in the five path and gave way at the three-eighths pole. ICE EXPRESS raced six wide around the first turn, bid at the three-quarters pole and gave way on the far turn.
