BRILLIANT BERTI was reserved early and three wide on the turn, came five wide off the turn by the quarter pole, made a bid and was given a pop left handed with the crop by the furlong marker and responded well to edge clear and remained clear to the wire to prove best. HERCHEE was well placed on the inside, blocked leaving the turn by the quarter pole, split rivals by the three sixteenths to make a bid but was out-kicked by the winner in a game effort. NEAT was reserved early on the outside, came six wide by the quarter pole, then rallied well but needed more. IN A JAM was allowed to settle early, two wide on the turn, swung out four wide leaving the turn and made a bid but flattened out late, held on to the last spot in the superfecta. DEPICTION was bumped at the start, reserved early and made it to the inside on the turn, eased out on the turn, came five wide off the turn and steadied slightly leaving the quarter pole, then once clear and had a late rally. LUCKY JEREMY tracked the pace and made a three wide bid but faded in the final furlong. KENTUCKY GO GO passed the tiring rivals. ARMY OFFICER was settled on the inside and weakened. KARLWITHANARL was not a threat. ASPENITE pressed the pace and made a two wide bid to vie for command in between rivals but then was empty. DRUNK ON SAKE set the pace on the inside and gave way.
