BARNES traded brushes with an outer rival passing the nine sixteenths pole while securing forward inside position, stalked around the turn, tipped outside of the clearing leader to take aim in upper stretch, drifted out while pursuing into the final furlong, straightened briefly before flopping leads at the sixteenth pole, closed in while drifting out once more in the closing stages, bid nearing the wire and prevailed via a head-bob. INNOVATOR broke outwardly, showed the way in the three to two path into the turn, drew clear entering the lane, dug in as an outer bidder threatened in the late stages and got nailed at the wire. SINISTER SMILE was bumped and forced outwardly by an inner rival at the start, pursued from midpack three wide, shifted out to the five path in upper stretch and moved up to edge show late. GREAT MOMENT broke out and bumped a foe at the start, lacked speed while tucking to the inside into the turn, shifted out to the four path into the lane, brushed an inner rival while moving forward between foes in the final furlong and prevailed for fourth. COUNTER ELITE was fractious in the starting gate, broke slow and shied hard from an inner rival at the start, raced at the rear two wide, shifted out to the five path into the lane, floated wider in upper stretch, then improved late but missed fourth. ABSOLUTELY HOT exchanged light contact with an inner rival passing the nine sixteenths pole, stalked forwardly two wide and between horses into the bend, shifted out to the four path in upper stretch, chased while hanging on his left lead, improved to show in the final furlong but tired between horses late. KINGSMERE pursued from midpack two wide and between horses, tucked to the inside in upper stretch and lacked a bid. LOTTERY WIN stalked three wide, ranged closer around the turn, but faded in upper stretch then took contact from an outer rival while tiring late. COLONEL CALIENTE broke slowly, raced at the rear along the inside, swung out to the six path into the lane and made

little impact. D'ORO BOY pursued from midpack along the inside and weakened.
