DEEP SATIN dropped from the two path to the rail early on the first turn, was well placed while rated just off the pace, raced inside to the two path on the far turn, was roused near the five-sixteenths pole then driven into upper stretch in the four path, chased the leader into the final furlong, gained to make a bid at the sixteenth-pole and got under good handling to narrowly prevail. IN OUR TIME established a forward position early, tucked from the three path to the two path early on the first turn, stalked outside without cover, was given her cue in the two path on the far turn, made a bid while a touch further out into upper stretch, gained the lead in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, led under a drive into the final sixteenth but was caught while able to get the place. HEREDIA (GB) broke a step slow, rounded the first turn in the two path, was reserved near the back under a snug hold, traveled around the far turn in the two then three path while roused, turned into upper stretch in the six path, rallied outside into the final furlong and finished with good energy to just miss while up for the show. LES REYS (FR) was taken in hand early then reserved on the inside, continued to save ground on the far turn, was roused outside the quarter-pole then came under a drive in upper stretch, gained in the two path into the final furlong, made a bid near the sixteenth-pole but just missed the trifecta. WAY TO BE MARIE went around the first turn in the two path, settled on the outside but with cover, was roused while moving from the two path to the three path on the far turn, came into upper stretch in the five path, gained while chasing into the final furlong and finished willingly but just missed the superfecta. EDICT (ARG) moved in while going to the front, dropped from the two path to the rail early on the first turn, was well rated while setting the pace, controlled the action while inside on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole then headed in upper stretch, battled under a drive into the final furlong and weakened. ALLURING ANGEL (GB) was reserved at the back on the inside, came under urging with three furlongs to run, shifted to the three path into the stretch and gained ground but failed to impact. THREE-QUARTER AND SEVEN-EIGHTHS FRACTIONS WERE OMITTED DUE TO A TIMING ISSUE
