FOLLOW THE MONEY stalked the pace in the four path and bid late for the show. HIGHEST MEMORIES stalked the pace between foes and lacked a late bid inside. KINGSBURY ROAD was bumped at the start, raced in the three path and rallied belatedly in the four path. RICH KINGDOM saved ground, angled to the five path on the far turn and rallied late. CHICORY BLAZE saved ground to no avail. HOOSIER DADDY NOW

EQUIBASE

stalked the pace inside, bid at the quarter pole and gave way in the stretch. RUN AWAY ROJO raced in the four path and lacked a late bid. KING ICE was bumped at the start, saved ground, bid in early stretch and faltered. DOUBLEDOGJUSTICE was unrushed early and was bumped on the far turn. COMMANDER STORM raced in the four path, was checked on the far turn and gave way.
