CHAPMAN'S PEAK got away well despite being lightly bumped, was forced out five to six wide into the first turn, settled into stride up the backstretch, advanced into the far turn stalking the leaders three to four edged away. BLAST FURNACE shifted in three to four wide early mid-pack, moved out advancing outside four to five wide, bid at the three-sixteenths taking a narrow lead, dueled, was outfinished. GOLD SOVEREIGN bumped a rival at the start, settled off the pace near the inside, advanced three to four wide on the far turn, gained steadily in the stretch, missed place. PEAK PERFORMER broke outwardly, was prominent early inside then eased back and switched out, stalked about mid-pack going two to three deep on the far turn, kept on in the stretch. ABBI FEDE bumped a rival at the start, vied for the lead then moved to the fore, set the pace up the backstretch, was inside on the far turn,

overtaken in upper stretch, weakened some. ENGLISH ROCKER tucked in early settling inside off the pace, moved out a bit on the far turn, rallied mildly between foes in the stretch. CRYSTAL HILL was bumped into a rival at the start, raced quite wide four to six deep, made a mild advance outside on the far turn but could not sustain the effort. MAKI MONARCHY was reluctant to load, moved forward four wide on the first turn, shifted in for the far turn still close, dropped back and faded. MONTERREY broke a bit awkwardly, raced at the back and made no impact. POWER OF WILL was bumped at the start, had forward position between then shifted in to track inside, faltered. SPY was well-placed up close between foes, chased briefly, steadily dropped back, was eased, walked off.
