SWIRLING EIGHTS stalked from outside racing mostly three to four wide, took closer order midway on the turn, was in command by the five-sixteenths, moved clear past the quarter pole, opened up at that juncture and held safe. VIVALDI was in behind off the rail about two wide, rallied between foes, secured the place while no real threat to the winner. POST GAME stalked from outside, raced mostly four to five wide, kept on fighting inside a rival to get the nod for show. ABUELO settled off the pace two to three wide, advanced while moving out, entered the stretch five to six deep, kicked on mildly but was

outfinished for show honors. THUNDER ROLL tracked from inside in good position, moved out near the three-eighths, was three to four wide after that marker, was within range coming into upper stretch but lacked the needed late kick. LANGDON was outpaced early racing outside, shifted in past the five-eighths, saved ground, came out past the eighth pole, ran on. NASH POTATOES settled outside at the rear, moved out five wide coming past the three-eighths, needed more. ROCKIN HIS SOX OFF was forwardly-placed stalking then pressing the leader outside two to three wide, bid between foes taking a narrow brief lead past the seven-sixteenths, steadily weakened past the quarter pole. ST. EMILION stalked from between foes in the second flight, dropped back and faded. OUR SLICEOF HEAVEN was coaxed to the lead soon after the start, set the pace inside, faced pressure and was overtaken past the seven-sixteenths, faltered and faded.
