TUMBARUMBA bumped an inner rival at the start, vied two wide while being kept in the three path around the turn, got floated out to the four path while sparring in upper stretch, battled gamely with his inner counterpart through the final furlong and prevailed. MOST WANTED leaned out and bumped a rival at the start, vied for the lead inside of the eventual winner while taking the turn in the two path, dueled with that one while moving out to the three path in upper stretch, gamely battled into deep stretch but was bested. INDISPENSABLE stalked outside of the top pair and from the four path, chased under urging around the turn, pursued in the five path into the lane and ran on while hanging on his left lead. WHO DEY raced off of the pace in the four path, fanned out to the six path into the lane and stayed on willingly. THREE TECHNIQUE stalked along the inside, chased the top pair while under urging in the two path around the turn, shifted out to the four path into the lane and gave way. WILL TAKE IT got briefly antsy just before the off, bobbled when the gates sprung and was squeezed back between horses at the start, raced off of the pace in the two path and failed to factor. SURLY FURIOUS was bumped between horses at the start, trailed in the three path and got outrun.
