MO FOR US bumped with an inner foe at the start, tracked behind the leaders and from the two path, tipped to issue a bold challenge outside of the leading trio entering the lane, drove clear while drifting out leaving the three sixteenths pole and was kept to task through the final furlong. MEZCALIFORNIA raced off of the pace in the five path, tucked down to the three to two path while trailing around the bend, moved out four wide while building momentum in upper stretch, ran on to gain place in midstretch and was second best. BLACK GINGER bumped with an outer foe at the start,, vied two wide and between horses, got outkicked by outer bidders in upper stretch, gave way while dueling for show with an outer counterpart through the final furlong and narrowly prevailed. MASCARA bumped the outer stall door before being bumped between horses at the start, vied three wide into and around the turn, led narrowly reaching the lane, but got outkicked by outer rivals in upper stretch, vied for show while giving way through the final furlong and missed that position. MILA ROSE pressed four deep early on, chased while failing to sustain pressure into the turn, then gave way once floated to the five path nearing the lane. SHE'S NO ANGEL set a pressured pace along the inside, vied with an outer pair around the turn and weakened in upper stretch.
