The Breeders' Cup is one of the most prestigious events in international horse racing — a two-day championship that brings together the best horses, trainers, and jockeys from around the world. Held annually at rotating premier racetracks in the United States, it serves as the culmination of the Thoroughbred racing season. Featuring 14 Grade I races and more than \$30 million in total prize money, the Breeders' Cup crowns champions across every division — from sprinters and turf specialists to juveniles and the elite contenders in the \$6 million Breeders' Cup Classic. Because it attracts competitors from North America, Europe, Asia, and beyond, the event is often called the "World Championships" of horse racing. Beyond the competition, the Breeders' Cup is also a celebration of the sport itself combining world-class racing, fashion, and pageantry with an atmosphere that rivals the Kentucky Derby or Royal Ascot.



Handicapping Thoughts to consider for Breeders Cup Friday


The wait is over — the **Breeders' Cup World Championships** are here, and with them comes the most electric two days in horse racing. Friday belongs to the **future** — a showcase of the world's best **two-year-olds** competing for glory, headlines, and early favoritism on the Road to the Kentucky Derby and Oaks.

This is where stars are born. From the Juvenile Turf sprints to the marquee **Breeders' Cup Juvenile**, these young talents step onto racing's grandest stage to prove their class, their courage, and their potential to define the sport's next era. For bettors, it's a chance to find value before the rest of the world catches on — to identify brilliance before it becomes legend.


Keep in mind that these young horses are evolving every day. **Breakout performances are born on this stage.** Handicapping the Breeders' Cup Juvenile races isn't just about what a horse *has* done — it's about anticipating what it *can* and *will* do today.

Pay close attention to horses stretching out in distance and expect the best of this group to show noticeable development under the bright lights. The winner may not simply repeat their last effort but instead reveal a **new dimension** of talent. Look for youngsters with the pedigree and mental toughness to thrive at this level. And don't overlook the international invaders. Horses shipping in from around the globe — especially the Europeans — bring deep turf pedigrees and come from barns that have mastered the art of winning on Breeders' Cup weekend.




The European contingent brought a strong group this year with 6 of the 12 starters. They should be considered carefully. The best of the group looks to be Obrien's True Love, this one is coming off a G1 win and has never been worst then 2nd. From the American group Intricate Spirit, Cy Fair and Schwarzenegger come in with a good shot all coming off wins.

This group will be tough to separate, keep an eye on the AE's if any runners are scratched.


The distance will be Key in this race. Look for those bred to go long and expect improvement from shorter efforts.



Aidan O'Brian ships in Precise who appears to be a standout in this field, but the post draw may have opened the door for some other possibilities.




Key Contenders


Baffert's Brant comes into the race after 2 wins over the Del Mar surface, expect this one to fire a big shot.

This large field going a mile suggests a fast pace as horse try to get position. This could lead to a situation where some closers pick up the pieces in this one.

Key Contenders

Gstaad comes in off a string of 2nd against Europe's best but looks like the one to beat here. Bottas the undefeated runner for the Clement stable has the right closing style to make some noise in this race. Argos from the Riley Mott barn is coming off a win at Woodbine and could be ready to repeat the effort.

Handicapping Thoughts to consider for Breeders Cup Saturday

If Friday is about the future, **Saturday is about supremacy.** The sport's brightest stars — champions, veterans, and late bloomers — converge for racing's richest, most prestigious card. Every division is on display, from sprinters blazing down the stretch to turf titans and Classic contenders chasing immortality.




Key Contenders






Key Contenders


The McPeek barn has been hot, Mystik Dan in an upset photo over Nysos and White Abarrio.

Stellify from the Cox barn is a must at 30-1. Clement's Bellezza should outrun her odds with a real shot to get into the money. Dimond Rain who lost by a head to She feels Pretty will be looking to reverse the outcome.

The euros will be most likely over bet in this one, a great opportunity to get a trifecta home with some double-digit odds and end the 2025 Breeders' Cup on a profitable note.
