SASSMASTER coaxed from the gate, knocked heads briefly for the front before easing off to chase along the inside through the first turn and then two to three paths off the inside down the backstretch, went just off the inside through the far turn coming under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, angled four wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command just outside the eighth pole, dug in to inch away in the late stages. EXPECT THE BEST raced four then three wide through the first turn, prompted the leader from the outside three paths off the rail down the backstretch and three wide through the far turn advancing to take command inside five-sixteenths remaining, spun three wide into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was caught just outside the eighth pole, battled on to the finish to safely secure the place honors. THUNDEROUSLY just off the inside through the first turn, chased three to four paths off the rail down the backstretch, tucked inside half a mile from home, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and spun three wide into upper stretch, ran on to secure the show honors while well clear of the rest. STATESMAN raced just off the inside through the first turn, then chased five then four wide commencing a four wide inside three furlongs to run through the latter portion of the far turn to reach contention swinging six to seven wide into upper stretch, couldn't sustain the move straightened away into upper stretch having passed tired rivals and kept on to the finish for the last major share. HOP SING stumbled at the break but broke on top despite it, cut the pace just off the inside under pressure from EXPECT THE BEST to the outside, came under a ride near the five-sixteenths, yielded the front inside that station and continued just off the inside at the top of the stretch, then tired through to the finish. IRON DOME coaxed from the gate, raced five wide into the first turn and then four then three wide through that bend, chased four to five paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked three wide through the far turn and was ridden along with seven-sixteenths to go, continued three wide into upper stretch and tired. UNIVERSE three then two wide through the first turn, chased four then three wide under light coaxing midway on the far turn, tipped five wide into upper stretch and tired.
