CAJUN SPIRIT pressed the early pace from the inside, tracked the pace up the backstretch, inched closer entering the second turn, responded along the rail to gain the margin and drew clear late under steady urging. SIR TIZ well placed from the inside, dropped back up the backstretch, altered outside, responded and rallied late for the place. SAND PIT ROAD stalked the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, responded but could not keep pace. GRIT dueled from between foes for the early margin, gained a clear margin up the backstretch, widen the effort through the second turn, remained forward but had nothing left. MR. BO JINGLES outrun early, advanced outside entering the second turn but could only improve position. THUNDER WEST dueled from the inside and tired. EASY ROLLER was never a threat. BLUE RIBBON GENT forced the early pace and tired. BIG PEPS dueled from the outside and faded. CAJUN CROWNE was never close. DREWSIZZLE showed little.
