OCEAN KNIGHT vied from the six path down the backstretch shortly after the start with a pair to his inside, eased off a bit to prompt the top pair tucking four then three wide into the turn as those foes did likewise, advanced under his own power to issue a challenge nearing the quarter pole, seized command in hand and swung five wide into upper stretch, got called upon as a trio flanked him three-sixteenths from home, dug in under a drive rebuffing JUST CALL KENNY to the outside nearing the sixteenth marker and confronted by a pair to the inside, came under an off sided stick and dug in gamely to hold on by a head at the wire. NOBLE MOON five wide near the rear early on, tucked three to four wide into the turn coming under urging by midway, swung four wide into upper stretch, shifted to the two path three-sixteenths out under a drive and issuing a challenge in tandem with STRONG STIPULATION down on the fence, latched on a sixteenth out fighting on between foes through to the wire and missed on the line. STRONG STIPULATION bobbled at the start, raced three wide near the rear, tucked to the rail with nine-sixteenths remaining coming under a ride nearing the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into upper stretch, rallied up the rail to threaten inside a pair through the final eighth, battled on inside those rivals to the finish in a bit tight in the last stride in a good effort. JUST CALL KENNY six wide early on, chased five then four wide in close aim of the front through the turn, got put to encouragement five-sixteenths from home, spun six wide into upper stretch, issued a bid a furlong out threatening for it all, ultimately was rebuffed in the final sixteenth while along for the last major share. SECOND CITY coaxed along chasing four wide early on, took to the two path with nine-sixteenths remaining, came under a ride three furlongs out, angled out six wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid but could not impact the top four. FACE OF WINNER hustled from the start, ranged up to vie three to four wide loosely between foes, pressed the leader three wide through the turn coaxed along, faded nearing the quarter pole and was lightly pinched out as DAY OF FURY floated three wide at that station and faltered in the drive. DAY OF FURY coaxed from the start, cut a pressured pace three then two wide through the turn hounded to the outside by FACE OF WINNER, had OCEAN KNIGHT advance nearing the quarter pole and was fully extended nearing that station, got headed for command, floated three wide for home pinching FACE OF WINNER lightly as that rival faded between foes, then gave way in upper stretch.
